

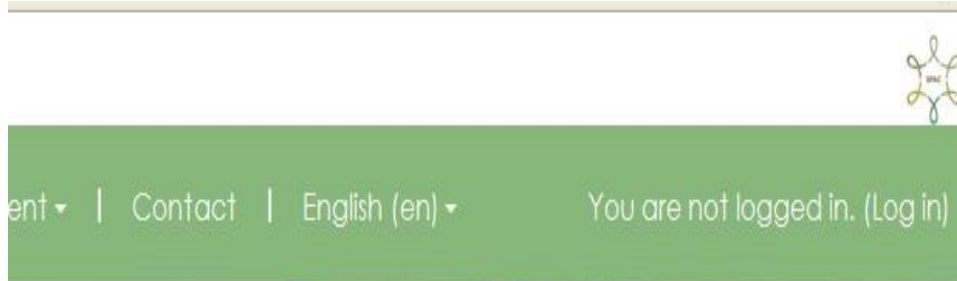
Registration of users in the database

All users of the e-learning platform (teachers, course creators, students) must first be enrolled in the platform database (need to create an account)

This can be done in two ways:

1. Students can create an account themselves, or
2. An account can be created by an authorized person (manual enrollment)

1. In order to create an account (self enrollment), visitors to the site must do the following:

Hi! For full access to courses you'll need to take a minute to create a new account for yourself on this web site. Each of the individual courses may also have a one-time "enrolment key", which you won't need until later. Here are the steps:

1. Fill out the [New Account](#) form with your details.
2. An email will be immediately sent to your email address.
3. Read your email, and click on the web link it contains.
4. Your account will be confirmed and you will be logged in.
5. Now, select the course you want to participate in.
6. If you are prompted for an "enrolment key" - use the one that your teacher has given you. This will "enrol" you in the course.
7. You can now access the full course. From now on you will only need to enter your personal username and password (in the form on this page) to log in and access any course you have enrolled in.

Create new account

- Pay attention to the instructions;
- Points 5,6,7 are valid only if the course creator or teacher allows this in course settings.

Complete the form (fields marked with * are required) and click on "Create my new account"

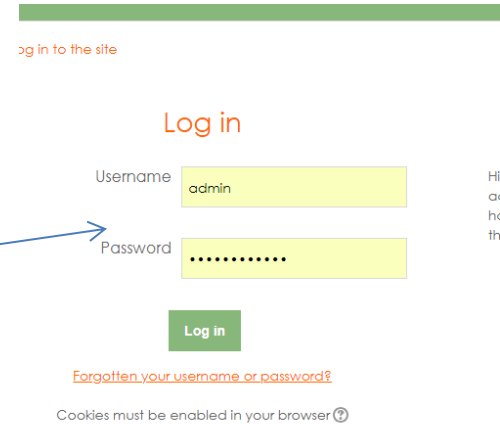
-You will receive an email with a confirmation link. Click this link and the account will be created
